Guide to Montgomery County (MO) Research

Most of the published county resources available at the Maryland Center for History and Culture can be located in section MF187 of the Main Reading Room (the row farthest from the reference desk). Books on specific counties or regions of Maryland are arranged alphabetically by county beginning with Allegany County in the northeast stacks and continuing across the room in the southeast stacks of the Reading Room. Some records are also available on microfilm or in pamphlet form. Patrons may access microfilm and those books on the first floor of the Main Reading Room themselves; however, pamphlets must be retrieved by the staff. Since searching the Library's online catalog by county name would result in too many hits, we have listed below some of the most popular resources for each county. Please note that this is not an inclusive list, just an example of the types of records available for each county and where you might find them. If you are interested in a particular type of record, you can search the Library's online catalog using specific key words.

An act of the assembly of Maryland in 1776 formed Montgomery County out of the lower section of Frederick County, itself carved out of Prince George's County in 1748. Maryland ceded a small part of Montgomery County to the federal government for the nation's capital. The county was named for General Richard Montgomery, a patriot hero who died at the Battle of Quebec.
